Thank you to everyone who joined us & tested their knowledge at our Annual Quiz Night, we had lots of fun and raised £68.00 and received 44kgs of food




from quizzers. Huge thanks to the **Red Lion Pub, St Kew Highway** for hosting the event.

The Storehouse is a local project helping local people. People donate second hand furniture, white goods & household items in good condition to the StoreHouse, and these are given free of charge to someone in need or sold for a reasonable price in our shop.
